

Note.—For the convenience of the readers, English translation of Chapter XIV is given hereunder :

CHAPTER XIV INTERMEDIATE EXAMINATION

1. Prior to admission to Intermediate Examination or starting studies of prescribed course, it shall be necessary for each candidate to have passed the High School Examination or High School Technical Examination of the Board or examination declared equivalent to it (High School) by regulation.

2. Following examinations are declared equivalent to the High School of the Board for the purpose of making the candidates eligible for the study of prescribed course of Intermediate Examination—

(1) Matriculation Examination of any University properly established in India, which is admissible for this purpose by the Board, Matriculation Examinations of the following University are admissible by Board—

Allahabad, Punjab, Bombay, Calcutta, Patna, Benaras and Aligarh :

Provided that in respect of Bombay University the candidate should have passed in First Class or Second Class or with 35 per cent of marks in each subject.

Note.—Matriculation examination of Benaras Hindu University and Aligarh Muslim University means entrance test for the first and High School Examination of the second.

(2) High School Leaving Certificate Examination of U.P. or any other State, with this condition that, that examination is accepted as equivalent to matriculation examination by properly established University in that State.

(3) Cambridge School Certificate (which was previously called as Senior Local) Examination.

(4) Diploma Examination of Chief Colleges.

(5) High School Examination of European Schools in Madhya Pradesh or other States.

(6) High School Certificate Examination of High School Education Board of Madhya Pradesh.

(7) High School Final and Matriculation Examination and High School Final Examination conducted by Matriculation Examination Board, Burma which was previously called as Anglo Vernacular High School and English High School Examination of Burma.

Note.—With regard to those Indian students, who are ousted from Burma, passed candidates in other subjects in addition to Burma in Matriculation examination of Rangoon University, obtained minimum marks separately in different subjects and in addition to Burma, obtained required minimum total marks in all subjects, are eligible for admission to appear in Intermediate Examination.

(8) Matriculation Examination of Landon University.

(9) English School Leaving Examination of Travancore State.

(10) High School Leaving Certificate Examination of Hyderabad (Deccan) with this condition that the candidate has passed in first or second class.

(11) Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination of Mysore with this condition that the candidate has been declared eligible for admission to University course.

(12) Diploma Examination of National Indian Military College, Dehradun (which was previously known as Sainik School, Dehradun and originally called as Royal Indian Military College.)

(13) High School Examination of Secondary Education Board, Delhi with this condition that the candidate has passed the examination with such five subjects which are sanctioned for High School Examination of Secondary Education Board, Uttar Pradesh.

Notes.—Following subjects of High School Examination of Delhi Board should be deemed similar subject sanctioned for U.P. Board Examinations :

- (a) Physical Action Science and Health Science;
- (b) Subjects coupled with organised parts of two subjects i.e. Elementary Civics, Elementary Economics and Indian History, etc.

[Regarding those candidates, who have passed High School Examination of Delhi Board upto 1937, counting of five sanctioned subjects should be made on the basis of rules applicable to them at that time.]

(14) Central Board of Secondary Education, Ajmer [which was previously called Board of High School and Intermediate Education, Rajputana (Ajmer and Marwar also inclusive), Madhya Bharat and Gwalior, Ajmer and later on it was named as Board of High School and Intermediate Education, Ajmer Bhopal and Vindhya Pradesh, Ajmer.]

(15) Higher Educational Test of Indian Navy which was previously called as Dufferin final passing out examination of Indian Merchantile. Marine Training-ship "Dufferin" for Executive or Engineering cadets.

(16) Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination of Kochin State with this condition that holder of certificate has been declared eligible for admission by Madras University in courses of study of the University.

(17) Matriculation Examination of National University, Ireland with the condition that the candidate has passed the examination in First or Second Division.

(18) Matriculation Examination of Usmania University, Hyderabad (Deccan) with this condition that the candidate has passed in first or second class.

(19) High School Examination of Board of Secondary Education, Dhaka

(21) High School Certificate Examination of Joint Board of Manchester, Liverpool, Leeds, Sheffield and Birmingham University, with this condition that the candidate has passed the examination in English, Mathematics, History, Geography and in two other subjects, which are sanctioned for High School Examination by Secondary Education Board, Uttar Pradesh.

(22) Matriculation examination of Joint Matriculation Board, Pretoria, South Africa.

(23) Higher Secondary Certificate Examination of Board of Secondary Education, Hyderabad with this condition that candidate has passed the examination in one attempt and obtained at least 35 per cent marks of the total marks and he is eligible for admission in pre-university class of Usmania University, Hyderabad.

(24) Matriculation Examination of Utkal University.

(25) I.A.F. Educational Test for Reclassification of Chief Air Craftsman.

(26) Special Certificate of Education of Indian Army.

(27) Vidyavinodini (Matriculation) Examination conducted by Prayag Mahila Vidyapeetha from 1946 to May 1964; with this condition that, that should be passed with Advance English as optional subject and total examination be passed altogether or with the interval of two years between one and other examinations (in not more than two parts).

— *Again*—Certificates granted by offices of Prayag Mahila Vidyapeetha, situated at 556, Daraganj, Allahabad and 196, Hewett Road, Allahabad shall be accepted.

(28) Senior School Certificate Examination of Lanka, which has been renamed as General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) Examination, Lanka.

(29) Higher Secondary Examination (one year or three years' course) of Board of Higher Secondary Education, Delhi.

(30) Adhikari Examination with English conducted by Gurukul University, Vrindavan, which has not been passed in parts in more than one year.

Note.—Word 'part' used in this regulation means 'Supplementary Examination'.

(31) Vidya Vinodini (Matriculation) Examination conducted by Prayag Mahila Vidyapeetha from 1946 to 1964 and High School Examination in English only under old Regulation 7 of Regulation of Chapter XIII of Secondary Education Board of Uttar Pradesh (as given in detailed book of 1955).

Again—Certificates granted by offices of Prayag Mahila Vidyapeetha situated at 556, Daraganj, Allahabad and 196, Hewett Road, Allahabad shall be accepted.

(32) Secondary School examination conducted by Secondary Education Board, Rajasthan, Ajmer (which was previously called High School and conducted by Rajasthan University, Jaipur).

(33) Vidyadhikari Examination conducted by Gurukul University, Kangri (Haridwar), with this condition that it has not been passed in parts.

Note.—Word 'Parts' used in this regulation means supplementary examination.

(34) Jamia Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Jamia-Milia Islamia, Delhi (which was previously called Junior Examination), with this condition that it has not been passed in parts.

(35) Matriculation Examination of Pre-Punjab University

(36) Matriculation Examination of Gauhati University.

- (37) Secondary School Certificate Examination conducted by Board of Secondary School Certificate Examination, Pune, Maharashtra State (which was conducted previously by Bombay Secondary School Certificate Examination Board).
- (38) Higher Secondary Technical Examination (three years' course) of Board of Higher Secondary Education, Delhi.
- (39) Matriculation Examination of Jammu and Kashmir University, Srinagar.
- (40) High School Examination conducted by Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Bharat, Gwalior.
- (41) Admission or Qualifying Examination conducted by Delhi University for those candidates who have passed matriculation or equivalent examination.
- (42) Purva Madhyama Examination or any other higher examination conducted by Sampurnanand Sanskrit University, Varanasi (conducted previously by Varanasey Sanskrit University, Varanasi).
- (43) School Final Examination conducted by Board of Secondary Education, West Bengal.
- (44) Matriculation Examination of Andhra University.
- (45) Secondary School Examination conducted by Bihar School Examination Board, Patna.
- (46) Matriculation Examination conducted by Vishwa Bharti University, West Bengal.
- (47) High School Certificate Examination conducted by Board of Secondary Education, Orissa.
- (48) Old Khand Madhyama (first two years' course) and special examination in additional subjects conducted by Sampurnanand Sanskrit University, Varanasi (previously conducted by Varanasey Sanskrit University, Varanasi).
- (49) Secondary School Certificate Examination conducted by Maha-kaushal Board of Secondary Education of Madhya Pradesh, Jabalpur.
- (50) Secondary School Certificate Examination conducted by Board of Secondary Education of Vidarbha, Nagpur.
- (51) Matriculation Certificate issued by Punjab University under social service regulation.
- (52) Following French Examinations of Pondicherry Administration—
- Bravet Alimaterre (French).
 - Bravet de et Duce Duller Cycle (French).
 - Bravet de Ensignment Primare Superior de lagve Indian (Tamil).
 - The Bravet the Langvendiate (Telugu, Malayalam).
- (53) S.S.L.C. Examination conducted by Board of Public Examination, Trivandrum, Kerala.

(54) Matriculation Examination of Bangla Desh Secondary Education Board, Dhaca.

(55) Secondary School Certificate Examination conducted by the Gujarat Secondary School Certificate Examination Board, Baroda.

(56) Akhil Bhartiya Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Central Board of Education, Ajmer, New Delhi.

(57) Visharad Examinations conducted by Kashi Vidyapeetha, Varanasi.

(58) Matriculation Examination of Sindh University, Pakistan.

(59) Higher Secondary Examination first part and other similar examination of Board of Secondary Education or legally established University in India with this condition that its examinations are admissible by Board and certificate of success in examination is given.

This similarity shall be sustained by the number of years of study required by the student later on for B.A. Examination of that State.

(60) Secondary Technical Examination conducted by Board of Technical Education, Uttar Pradesh, Lucknow.

(61) Indian Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (Standard Tenth Examination) conducted by Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi, passed in one attempt with five subjects.

(62) Matriculation Examination of Punjab School Education Board, Chandigarh.

(63) High School Leaving Certificate Examination of Board of School Education, Nagaland.

(64) Matriculation, Higher Secondary Part I and Part II Examination of Board of Education, Haryana, Chandigarh.

(65) Matriculation, Higher Secondary Part I and Part II Examination conducted by Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education (Simla).

(66) "Vidya Ratna" Examination of Gurukul Mahavidyalaya, Jwalapur, Saharanpur.

(67) Higher Secondary Examination (Class 11) conducted by Punjab School Education Board, Chandigarh.

(68) High School Leaving Certificate Examination conducted by Board of Secondary Education, Manipur, Imphal.

(69) Madhyamik School Final Examination and Higher Secondary Examination (Class 11) respectively of Tripura Board of Secondary Education, Agartalla.

2-A. Following conditions shall be applicable to those privately managed institutions which are not run on compulsory conditions under any Act or Charter. These conditions shall be applicable for the purpose of recognition of examinations conducted by its equivalent to High School Examination of the Board under Regulation 2, Chapter XIV :

- (1) A member representative of the Board shall be with such authority who approves prescribed courses of study for examination;
- (2) That institution shall allow its centre of examinations for inspection by the representative of the Board;
- (3) That institution shall pay travelling and daily allowances to the representatives of the Board as per rules of the Board.

These conditions shall be applicable to all those institutions applying for recognition of the Board and for those bodies also, whose examinations are admissible by the Board as equivalent to High School Examination under Regulation 2 (30) and (33) of this Chapter.

3. No candidate may be admitted in Intermediate Examination until two academic years have not lapsed after passing of High School or an equivalent examination by him :

Provided that candidates who have passed Cambridge School Certificate Examination or Indian School Certificate Examination (only upto December, 1974) conducted by Council of Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi or Higher Secondary Examination (one year or three years' course) or Higher Secondary School Technical Certificate Examination (three years' course) of Board of Higher Secondary Education, Delhi or Akhil Bhartiya Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education, Ajmer, New Delhi or demonstration of Multipurpose Higher Secondary Examination or Higher Secondary Examination or examinations for admission or eligibility or pre-university examination conducted by any legally established university or Board of Secondary Education in India, just after which three years' degree course commences, may be admitted in the Intermediate Examination in next academic year of passing the pre-examination.

Note.—Candidates appearing under this proviso are also eligible to appear as private candidates, if they satisfy the required conditions.

3-A. [Rescinded].

3-B. Notwithstanding the conditions of these regulations any examinee, who has passed Intermediate Technical Examination of the Board or an equivalent examination, can appear in the Intermediate Science Examination in the year next to that academic year, in which he passes the pre-examination.

Such examinees shall not be required to reappear in Hindi and marks obtained by them previously in these subjects shall be included.
